HUHS encourages all students to participate in local, state, and national elections. As part of your responsibility to promote good citizenship, as well as good scholarship, the university urges all students to register to vote.

If you are not registered to vote, register to vote today! Students eligible under state and federal law will have the opportunity to vote in future elections. Within the next four years, you may be getting a job, purchasing a home, getting married, starting a family, paying for healthcare, or starting your own business. The policies you vote on will influence your life after college.

The U.S. Election Assistance Commission is an excellent source of helpful information.
